

# SCHODL BUS \& CROSSWALK REMINDERS 

## ROADWAY SCENARIOS you may encounter with school buses

## TWO-LANE ROADWAY:

Many state laws require drivers to stay at least a minimum distance traveling behind a school bus at all times.

Motorists must stop for school buses and school vans when red lights are flashing. Be on the lookout for flashing yellow \& red lights and be ready to stop.

Never pass a school bus when its stop sign arm is down \& red lights are flashing.
Do not begin driving again until the flashing red lights are turned off, the stop sign is put back in place and the bus begins moving.

Be aware of children exiting the bus and moving into the roadway both in front and to the rear of the bus.

Violations are potentially dangerous, traffic citation fines are excessive and multiple violations can correlate to a suspended CDL.

Speed within the school zone is $\mathbf{1 5} \mathbf{~ m p h}$ hour.
On multi-lane roadways passing slower or stopped vehicles going in the same direction is prohibited as it is vision obstruction.

You must come to a complete stop when the school crosswalk are occupied by pedestrians.

When school bus stops for passengers, all traffic from both directions must stop!

## TWO-LANE ROADWAY

 WITH A CENTER TURNINE LANE:When school bus stops for passengers, all traffic from both directions must stopd

## FOUR-LANE ROADWAY WITHOUT A MEDIAN SEPARATION:

When school bus stops for passengers all traffic from both directions must stopt

DIVIDED HIGHWAY OF FOUR LANES OR MORE WITH A MEDIAN SEPARATION: When school bus stops for passengers, only traffic following the bus must stop.
